
If you have not already submitted your form, please do so at your earliest convenience. It will help us to stay within our budget and get all the Church bills paid.



FELLOWSHIP NEWS FOR MAY 2017

Greetings from the Fellowship Group!

Just a few short weeks ago, we celebrated the resurrection of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. Christos Anesti! Within 50 days of Holy Pascha, we celebrate two of the Great Feast Days of the Orthodox Christian Church, the Feast of the Ascension and Pentecost.



The Feast of the Ascension commemorates the Ascension of Christ into Heaven. Following His Resurrection, Jesus remained on earth among men for 40 days. On the 40th day, after blessing His apostles, Christ was taken up into Heaven and took His place at the right hand of God. As Orthodox Christians, we see Christ's Ascension as a sign and symbol of His second coming. Christ will return to the earth in the same manner as He left it, thus fulfilling God's will for mankind. This year, the Feast of the Ascension falls on Thursday, May 25th.

We continue to greet one another with Christos Anesti/Alithos Anesti (Christ has Risen/Truly He has Risen) throughout this month and until Pentecost, 50 days after Holy Pascha. This year, the Great Feast of Pentecost falls on Sunday, the 4th of June. Pentecost commemorates the descent of the Holy Spirit among the apostles and is seen as the full revelation of the Holy

Trinity...Father, Son and Holy Spirit. We traditionally refer to Pentecost as the beginning of the one Holy Catholic and Apostolic Church.

With these two Great Feast days upon us, the Fellowship group invites all of you to join us in prayer during the church services celebrating both the Ascension and Pentecost.

This month's Fellowship meeting takes place on Thursday, May 11th at 11:30 AM. In lieu of a regular meeting, we will be meeting for lunch at Pinhead Susan's

where a room has been reserved for us. Following lunch, those who wish to do so will carpool to the Rivers Casino to explore this new addition to the Schenectady scene. Next month's meeting will take place a the Hellenic Center on Thursday, June 8th at 11:30 AM. Our lunch menu is yet to be determined.


